TERRIER GROUP

SCOTTISH TERRIER (DOG)

CLASS 1 - Junior

1st – Mr. S. & Mrs. F. Drakes' **SAMSTEVEVER AT SHILOH**

Slightly slack tail in the heat, but worthy of CC, as has length of head, good head planes. Nose correct. Very dark eyes. Coat harsh and dense. Good bone. Broad rear. Moved well, holding strong topline. Tail well carried in Group.

CC & BOB. Best in Group.

TOY GROUP

PAPILLONS (DOG)

CLASS 2 – Open

1st – Miss A. Blanchard's **CH. KINGSHAVEN SILVER LINING AT HOTHERSALL**

Nice size and outline. Tail well carried. Plentiful coat and furnishings. Good head, ears well placed with some fringe. Tail well plumed. Moved well. CC, BOB, Best in Group

PAPILLONS (BITCH)

CLASS 3 - Junior

1st - Miss E. Blanchard's **RINGLANDS OPAL AT HOTHERSALL**

Not in full coat due to the heat, but the texture of coat and furnishings is good, fine muzzle, good blaze. Very large ears with fringe. Has a frill and plumed tail. CC & RBOB. Reserve in Group.

GUNDOG GROUP

WEIMARANERS (DOG)

CLASS 5 – LIMIT

1st – Ms. J. Atkinson's & Ms. G. Etienne's **WILSHIER KIT KAT**

Has a good outline, neck, head and tail carriage. Good moderate angulation, good shoulders and upper arm. Balanced head, ears well used. Coat still shows where he had a rash which needs to re-grow coat. He has good overall type but needs more training to show his best. At the moment his coat is too brown tinged due to his former rash. RBOB

WEIMARANERS (BITCH)

CLASS 6 – Open

1st – Mrs. N. Huey's **SH.CH. WILHIER BLAIZE**

Very tippy, quite a good colour. Good head and expression. Good neck and conformation overall. Sound in movement. Coat in good order. Well trained and presented. CC, BOB

SPANIELS (AMERICAN COCKER) (DOG)**CLASS 7 - Junior**

1st – Mr. T. Armstrong's **SANMALDOR COOPER**

Well trained and well presented. Good head, eyes, pigment and muzzle. Fine coat and furnishings. Tail well carried. Slightly long in loin and would prefer him slightly smaller, but he has a masculine head and outlook. Totally sound, well boned and bodied. Good expression. CC, BOB

SPANIELS (AMERICAN COCKER)(BITCH)**CLASS 8 - Junior**

1st – Miss M. Pooler's **SANMALDOR SUMMER**

Needs time to mature, but feminine with a pleasing head and eyes. Long ears well set. Good tail carriage and coat of nice texture. Has the essentials but needs time now. CC, RBOB

RETRIEVERS (GOLDEN)) (DOGS)**CLASS 9 – Minor Puppy**

1st – Miss A. Blanchard's **HOTHERSALL'S DRUMMER BOY**

Promising with a good head and expression. Nice neck, forechest and ribs. Short loin, well angulated rear. Not in full coat. Moved well.

CLASS 11 – Limit

1st – Mrs. J. Ray's **BURPHAM WINTER STORM OF THATCHER**

Nice overall type, head, neck and topline. Deep brisket, good angulation. Tail very slightly high on the move. Sound mover on good legs and feet. RCC

CLASS 12 – Open

1st – Miss S. Blandford's **HOTHERSALL MALVOLIO**

Very good overall type. Good neck, head and tail carriage. Good head planes, very good pigmentation. Good shoulders and excellent angulation. Coat and undercoat in good order. Sound on very good legs and feet. CC, BOB, Best in Group

RETRIEVERS (GOLDEN)(BITCHES)**CLASS 14 - Limit**

1st – Miss A. Blanchard's **HOTHERSALLS CLEOPATRA**

Well angulated. Tail carriage ok. Has lay back of shoulders. Good eyes, pigment and overall shape. Moved well. CC, RBOB

2nd – Mrs. L. Husband's **THATCHERS GOLDEN SKY**

Very close up, and much the same comments apply. Just a tad unsettled in movement on the day.

CLASS 15 - Open

1st - Mrs. J. Ray's **THATCHER'S HIGHLAND MOON**

Typy, good outline, neck and head carriage. Feminine head and outlook. Dark eyes. Sound mover. RCC

RETRIEVERS (LABRADOR) (DOG)**CLASS 17 –Open**

1st – Mrs. S. Leacock's **BENATONE SECRET MISSION OF THEBERTON**

Good outline, neck, topline and otter tail. Well angulated, deep brisket. Broad skull, good strong muzzle. Neat ears, excellent pigment. Hard, straight coat with undercoat. Very good mover. CC, BOB, Reserve in Group

RETRIEVERS (LABRADOR) (BITCHES)**CLASS 18 – Puppy**

1st – Mrs. C. Armstrong's **ZINZARA STAND ALONE**

Excellent coat texture, well angulated. Dark eyes, neat ears. Good neck. Needs more training to move at her best, as she is inclined to play.

CLASS 19 – Junior

1st – Mrs. J. Letourneau's & Mrs. J.C. Gourgon's **GLENAYRE ZOUK**

Black coat in excellent texture, very good overall, head, eyes, ears and type. Good front movement, just a tad unsettled in rear. Good tail and outline.

CLASS 20 - Limit

1st – Mr. & Mrs. A.. Moore's **CLAYTONHOLT SARAH OF MOORLANDS**

Nice head and expression, neat ears, very good pigment. Excellent hard coat. Moved ok. RCC

CLASS 21 – Open

1st – Mrs. Z. Gray-Marshall's **TREVENA SEPTEMBER SUNSET**

6 year old of pleasing overall type. Good head and expression, well made. Good angulation. Otter tail. Just a tad slack in front, strong rear drive. Excellent coat. CC & RBOB.

2nd - Mrs. R. Coghlan's **SH. CH.TREVENA APRIL ROSE CDX**

8 years in lovely order. Strong topline, feminine outlook. Held outline and moved well.

RETRIEVERS (FLAT COATED) (DOG)**CLASS 22 - Puppy**

1st – Mrs. Greenidge's **BRAEMIST NIGHTJAR IN PARADISE**

Good skull, slight stop, good length muzzle. Held outline and tail well. Needs time to mature and settle in front. CC, BOB

HOUND GROUP**BEAGLE (DOG)****CLASS 23 – Open**

1st – Mr. T. & Mrs. C. Bentley's **CH. DIALYNNE MESSENGER**

Very typy overall. Good skull and muzzle. Soft expression, strong pigment. Very firm in topline, good stern. Sound mover on well boned legs and good feet. CC, BOB, Best in Group

RHODESIAN RIDGEBACK (BITCH)**CLASS 24 - Open**

1st – Mrs. S.B. Hamilton-Outcalt's **WALTRIDGE MALIBU VAVAVOOM BY CROWNRIDGE**

Sound and with a good outline and tail carriage. White on chest and toes only and red coat of even colours all excellent. Good ridge and two crowns. CC, BOB and Reserve in Group.

UTILITY GROUP

AKITAS (DOGS)

CLASS 27 – Novice

1st – Mr. P. Waterman's **SNOW PHANTOM**

Short coupled, well proportioned, high set well curled tail. Harsh coat. Broad skull, strong muzzle, ears follow neckline. Moved well.

CLASS 28 - Open

1st – Mr. A. Pilgrim's **UK.CH. MELODOR RESIST'NCE IS FUTILE AT TONDAR**, CC, BOB, Best in Group, Reserve Best in Show

2nd – Dr. W. Welch's **UK.CH. REDWITCH I REST MY CASE AT ELTHOR**, RCC

Two super Akitas with all the essentials. Compact, square in outline, well curled tails. Ears follow neckline and good overall bone, colours and attitudes. 1st – excelled in movement and tightly curled tail – 2nd – excellent in neck and ear placement. Slightly lame in front on the day, which was a pity. The handler therefore withdrew him.

AKITAS (BITCHES)

CLASS 29 Minor Puppy

2nd – Mr. R.C. Toppin's **BROOWEN SUMARAI ESCAPEDE**

Needs time and teeth to settle. Has a pleasing harsh coat texture. Held topline, moderate angulation. Tail well curled. Still slightly slack in front but just a baby.

CLASS 30 – Puppy

1st – Mr. A. Taylor's **TOPAZ TABOO**,

Very typy and has all the essentials. Eyes well set, ears follow neckline, compact and sound mover. Coat harsh. RCC & Best locally bred Puppy in Show

CLASS 32 – Novice

1st – Mr. R. Sandiford's **TONDAR SUGAR AND SPICE**

21 months, still needs to settle a little in topline to look her best. Tail high set and well carried. Needs a bit more training to look her best. Coat harsh and stand off texture.

CLASS 33 – Open

1st Mr. M. Brathwaite's **TIFFANY'S TAMARA**

Good outline, head and tail carriage. Good skull and muzzle, ears follow neckline. Well boned. Coat hard and stand off. Moved well on good legs and feet. CC & RBOB

WORKING GROUP

BOUVIER DES FLANDRES(BITCH)

CLASS 35- Open

1st - Miss Margaret Ashby's **CH. FARLEYCROSS SO FAR SO GOOD OF CALLIOPE**

Square in outline, strong square skull, good muzzle, dark eyes. Well made overall, broad thighs, looks well let down. Dense coat. Sound mover. Well balanced bitch all round, neat head, good straight front, compact body, good coat texture, went well. CC, BOB & Reserve in Group

BULLMASTIFFS (DOGS)**CLASS 36 – Junior**

1st - Mr. F. Godson's **HOTHERSALL'S MR. BINGLEY**

Broad Skull, dark eyes and dark ears well set on the skull. Large nose and nostril, black mask and eye rims. Undershot teeth could be slightly closer. Coat close and clear in colour. Tail well carried. Very slightly slack in front but on such a hot day he held his outline well. RCC

CLASS 38 - Open

1st – Mr. P. Evelyn's **MURBISA CONNOR AT HOTHERSALL**

Dog of great strength, muscular and with good bone, body and tail carriage. Sound mover on good legs and feet. Close coat. Broad skull and muzzle. Would prefer slightly less wrinkle. Correct reverse scissor bite. CC, BOB

2nd – Mr. J. Jones' **PARABULL BULLDOZER**

Very typy, with width of skull and muzzle. Good topline and tail. Excellent coat. Just slightly lame of the day which was a great pity as he has excellent type.

BULLMASTIFFS (BITCHES)**CLASS 40 – Puppy**

1st – Mr. A.. Cater's **DUNJU DINKA**

Needs time to mature, but sound. Good skull, reverse scissor bite. Black muzzle and eye orbs. Would prefer darker ears but she has time. Best locally bred Puppy in Show

CLASS 41 – Junior

1st – Mr. O. Holder's **HOTHERSALL LADY GEORGIANA**

Very good outline and tail. Well angulated, strong neck, broad skull. Dark eyes, orbs, ears and eyes and nails. CC, RBOB & Best locally bred in Show

CLASS 42 – Maiden

1st – Mr. R. Bryan's **MORNING QUEEN**

Needs time to settle in movement and a bit more training, but she has width of skull and muzzle, black muzzle, orbs and ears.

CLASS 43 – Open

1st – Mr. P. Evelyn's **HOTHERSALL'S RED BEAUTY**

Very good overall type. Good skull, muzzle of good width. Dark muzzle, orbs and ears. Large nose and nostril. Sound. Close hard coat. RCC

MASTIFF (DOG)**CLASS 44 - Minor Puppy**

2nd – Mr. A .Godson's **MANSUETUDE MAURICE**

Fair length body, head developing well, coat well brindled, but today limping which spoiled his chances of CC. Very dark eye, well set. Good ears.

NEAPOLITAN MASTIFFS (BITCHES)**CLASS 45 – Junior**

1st - Mr. W. Small's **LORDAEMS SAVANNAH STAR AT FLANDERS**

Promising youngster with depth of lip, neat ears, good dewlap. Loping movement. Good coat and tail. Good loose skin.

2nd – Mr. W. Small's **LORDAEMS SUMMER SUN AT FLANDERS**

More upright and not yet depth of 1st.

No CC as immature.

DOBERMANNS (DOG)**CLASS 46 - Open**1st – Mr. P. Watermann's **CHARRON HALLEY'S COMET**

Long head with good parallel planes, almond dark eyes. Good neck and ribs, deep brisket, good tail carriage. Hard coat. Rich colour and sound. CC & BOB

DOBERMANNS(BITCH)**CLASS 47 – Novice**1st – Mr. P. Waterman's **SUDDENLY SUSAN**

Needs a bit more training, but held outline and moved ok. Has length of head, deep tan markings. Good angulations. Close hard coat. CC & RBOB

ROTTWEILERS (DOGS)**CLASS 51 - Junior**1st – Dr. W. Welch's **BORTERRA STONE MASON AT ELTHOR**

Good outline, slightly sloping croup. Good tail carriage. Good head, eyes and ears. Rich tan. Good coat and sound.

CLASS 52 – Limit1st – Mr. R. Alleyne's **RICHWOOD ARES THE WARLORD**

Typy overall. Good neck, topline and tail. Well angulated. Pleasing head. Sound. Very good coat. Compact, well proportioned. CC & RBOB

2nd – Mr. J. Harris' **ACTION MAN**

Slightly longer cast, not quite the movement of 1st but typy overall.

CLASS 53 – Open1st - Mr. Richard Alleyne's **CH. MONIFA BRIMSTONE AND FIRE**

Good outline and angulation, well bodied, well made. Dry head, dark eyes. Sound. Rich mahogany markings. RCC

2nd – Mr.L. Lavine's **GUNI'S ROMANCING THE STONE**

Pleasing head and expression, firm topline. Slack in front at moments, but he is only a youngster. Good rear and croup – needs time.

ROTTWEILERS (BITCHES)**CLASS 54 – Maiden**1st – Mr. J. Boyce's **FEONAS MERCEDE**

Good outline, deep brisket. Eyes could be darker. Nice neck and ribs.

CLASS 55 – Novice1st – Mr. R. Sandiford's **ALOE CARRIE**

Dark eyes. Rich tan markings. Slightly long on coat with good undercoat. Well angulated. RCC

CLASS 56 – Limit1st – Mr. R. Alleyne's **RICHWOOD ATHENA**

Very typy young bitch. Deep brisket. Dark eyes, broad skull, strong muzzle. Neat ears. Sound on the move. Well made, good croup, angulation and movement. Rich markings. Pencilling on feet. Coat in good order. CC & BOB

2nd – Mr. J. Harris' **CALI FORNIA**

Firm topline and tail carriage good. Tan markings. Sound mover. Well angulated.

GERMAN SHEPHERD DOGS (DOGS)**CLASS 62 – Minor Puppy**

1st – Miss D. Simpson's **ZUCKERLAND ZANADU**

Held outline well. Long tail well carried. Balanced overall. Promising youngster.

CLASS 58 – Puppy

1st – Mrs. S. Nieves' **VIDEX SHUGAR AT DANAMAN**

Very typical puppy. Very good ears and outlook. Very good neck, topline, chest and ribs. Long tail very well carried. Best Puppy in Show

2nd – Messrs. M. Worrell's, C. Charles' and D. Manning's **BARA BOSS VON SHOTAAN DELLA VINCIBAR**

Taller puppy, who is not so ready, at the in between stage. Sound and well handled.

CLASS 59 - Junior

1st – Mr. J. Clarke's & Miss S. Patel's **NETANYA ULK**

Typy youngster. Held outline, head and tail carriage well. Good head planes and ears.

CLASS 60 – Novice

1st – Mr. N. Lashley's **ZUCKERLAND XANADU**

Pleasing head planes, used ears well, deep brisket. Well angulated, hocks well let down. Coat in good order. Sound mover.

CLASS 61 - Limit

1st – Miss S. Patel's **SHOTAAN FRITZ OF NETANYA**

Good head planes, well set ears. Eyes could be slightly darker. Good depth brisket, angulation and tail. Coat in good order. Sound. Held his excellent outline on the move. RCC

CLASS 62 – Open

1st – Miss S. Patel's & Mr. D. Rezende's **CH. SILKENWOOD HYPERSONIC**

Very good head planes, ears, neck, chest and ribs, outline and tail. Very good mover. Very good coat. Sound. CC, BOB, Best in Group, Best in Show

2nd – Miss S. Patel's **CH. SILKENWOOD MARS OF NETANYA**

Another very typy and well angulated male. Sound.

GERMAN SHEPHERD DOGS(BITCHES)**CLASS 64 – Junior**

1st – Miss S. Patel's **NETANYA ULLA,**

Promising young bitch, very good outline, neck, head and tail carriage. Good head. Used ears well.

CLASS 65 – Maiden

1st – Mrs. S. Nieves' **MONIFA VANTA,**

Good head planes, used ears, still immature, but promising. Broad well angulated thighs. Long tail. Good mover.

CLASS 66 - Limit

1st – Miss S. Patel's **NETANYA TOPAZ,**

Promising but needs time to come to her best. Has good angulation. Good neck and head. Feminine head and expression.

CLASS 67 – Open

1st – Mr. M. Worrell's **SILKENWOOD POSY OF KIMBERLAND,**

Very typy young bitch. Excellent outline, head and tail carriage, well ribbed, good croup and tail set and carriage. Sound. Coat good. CC, RBOB

2nd – Mr. O. Holder's **MONIFA RANI,**

Very good head and expression, good neck and angulation. Long tail well carried. Sound mover. RCC

BOXER (DOG)

CLASS 71 - Junior

1st – Mrs. J. Yacomine's **FIRESTORM ALL SHOOK UP**,

Good skull, good muzzle, dark eyes, well apart, fitting lips. Good chest and ribs, well angulated. Good bone, legs and feet. Coat well brindled. Sound mover. CC & BOB

BEST STUD DOG – Miss S. Patel's & Mr. D. Rezende's **CH. SILKENWOOD HYPERSONIC**

BEST VETERAN – Mr. & Mrs. A. Moore's **CH. ACHENBURG HARMONY OF MOORLANDS**

Good length head, good parallel planes. Ears well used. Good eyes and expression. Good neck and topline, well ribbed. Deep brisket. Well angulated. Good coat and condition.

All Veterans were a credit.

The Golden Retriever, Mrs. J. Ray's **SH.CH. BURPHAM MOONSONG OF THATCHER**, had a lovely expression and outlook. Well made and in good coat. Easy mover.

The Rhodesian Ridgeback, Mrs. L. Husband's **CH. TOTAL PANDAMOMIUM BY CROWNRIDGE C.D.**, was a very good example of the breed with pleasing head and outlook and good coat.

It was a pleasure to judge so many dogs who despite the heat had wonderful temperaments and the owners/handlers were gracious in accepting their placings.
