TOY GROUP

PAPILLON – PUPPY –

1st – **KINGSHAVEN SILVER LINING AT HOTHERSALL** (D) - 9 months old black & white with very good ear carriage, well placed eyes giving a true expression. In a well presented coat. Good shower, fully enjoying his day

out, CC & BOB; Best in Group.

2nd – **KINGSHAVEN SIMPLY SOPHIE AT HOTHERSALL** (B) - Litter sister to 1st, again well presented, as one would expect not the body as first, good on the move. Res. Best in Group.

UTILITY GROUP

FRENCH BULLDOG – OPEN –

1st – Mr. H. Jordan's **CH. JAFRAK FANTASY ISLAND** (B) - Nice compact 2 year old bitch, nice head & expression, uses her ears to advantage, good cobby body free on the move, CC & BOB.

AKITAS (DOGS)

MINOR PUPPY – 1st – Mrs. C. Williams' **ANDLET CESAR** - A sound, well advanced dog for 7 months. Head handles well, straight front, neat feet. Good neck & topline, looks good on the move;

PUPPY – 1st – Mr. L. Beckles' **SHOGUN SAMURAI** - A very good looking 7 months old puppy, lovely head & expression, not the front movement of the minor puppy, needs to be more positive on the move.

JUNIOR – 1st – Mr. R. Leacock's **FAST TRAVELLER** - A 16 months old who needs more ring training both when being assessed & on the move. Sound in bone & body, good ear carriage, not free in movement.

RETRIEVERS (GOLDEN) (DOGS)

MAIDEN – 1st – Miss P. Hutchinson's **THATCHERS HIGH TIDE** - A 19 month old with good head and expression. Lovely out going temperament. I would like more bone and body.

RETRIEVER (GOLDEN) – (BITCHES)

JUNIOR – 1st – Ms. S. Scrimshaw's **THATCHER POSITIVE PLANNING** - Just over 1 year old, nice profile, good front and rear, could do better on the move. Best L/B.

NOVICE – 1st - Master L. De Freitas' **CANINA VICTORIA SWIRL OF WINDY LODGE** - Just 1 year old, I would like more bone and body. Good neck and topline, needs to put a little more into her movement.

LIMIT - 1st – Mrs. A. Ramphal's **ALISSA'S MARA** - Now nearly 5, good head and expression. Well boned front, nice topline, well presented, but could do more on the move. RCC.

OPEN - 1st – Miss A. Blanchard's **SH.CH. STANROPH SUPER SUSIE** - A well balanced 2 year old not just in full coat today. Head handles well, good body shape, looks good standing and scores points on the move. CC & Res BOB.

RETRIEVERS (LABRADOR) - (DOGS)

PUPPY – 1st – Mrs. C. Armstrong's **BLARNEYSTONE JESTER** - A nice 9 month old, good head & expression, lovely temperament. Good topline. Just needs more training. Best Puppy & Best L/B Puppy.

JUNIOR – 1st – Mrs. Z. Gray-Marshall's **THURBAJEN'S PAPERBACK HERO OF ZINZARA** - A good looking 16 month old black dog, in lovely coat and condition. Clean body lines, sound in bone and body, free on the move. RCC.

OPEN – 1st – Prof. & Mrs. T. Hassell's **CLAYTONHOLT BENNAHIE OF KHOTSO** - A well balanced 4 year old with good head and expression. Sound front & rear, nice deep chest, covers the ground with ease. CC & Res BOB.

RETRIEVERS (LABRADOR) – (BITCHES)

OPEN – 1st – Mrs. S. Leacock's **SH.CH. BOURNECOTT OSPREY OF CLAYTONHOLT OF THEBERTON** - A lovely 7 year old shown in top condition. So sound in bone and body, well boned straight front, nice compact feet. Good rear angulation. So easy on the move. CC, BOB & Res. Best In Group.

2nd – Mrs. Z. Gray-Marshall's **TREVENA SEPTEMBER SUNSET** - Nice 2 year old with well placed eyes and ears. Good neck and topline, free on the move. RCC & Best L/B.

3rd – Mrs. R. Coghlan's **SH.CH. TREVENA APRIL ROSE CDX** - Lovely out going temperament, nice outline, not just the substance or movement of first 2.

SPANIELS (AMERICAN COCKER)

OPEN – 1st – Mrs. D. Davies' **SH.CH. AFTERGLOW ANDANTE** - A 4 year old dog with nice body shape well covered with a good textured coat which was well presented. Could stand better at


